GSEM IN TOP 30 MOST IN-DEMAND FACULTIES

In January the School was ranked among top 30 in-demand faculties of Russian biggest universities from the viewpoint of employers in 2016. According to Dmitry Tolmachev, GSEM Director, economists remain in-demand with all kinds of employers. Graduates of master's programmes in economics with basic training in mathematics, physics and other hard sciences are considered the most qualified.

The ranking is compiled by the Russian company Future Today that specialises in projects focusing on employer band development and graduate recruitment. It's been developed with the support of McKinsey and supervised by Russian biggest employers.

CAREER DAY FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

On February 13th prospective international students learnt about opportunities of studies at GSEM, programmes, exams and possible career paths.

Liudmila Pliner, Head of International Affairs Office, told about the School, programmes that we offer, academic mobility opportunities and corporate partners.

Dr. Hans Wiesmeth, Head of the Laboratory for International and Regional Economics and member of the GSEM International Academic Council, described the prospects of an economist's career and research opportunities.

Students also got to meet heads and graduates of some GSEM programmes taught in English: International Economics and Business (EPAS accredited), International Management, IT-Innovations in Business.



Finally, students took part in the master class conducted by Zhanna Belyaeva, Head of the programme International Economics and Business, and Alberto Ferraris, GSEM Research Fellow.

GSEM INTERNATIONAL STAFF VISIT EKATERINBURG SCHOOLS

Dr. Gurgen Aslanyan visited Lyceum №110 to give a master class and career guidance for senior high school students. The professor taught a course Models of Economic Growth for Master students of the programme Theoretical and Experimental Economics, as well as a series of lectures for the students of the Bachelor programme International Economics and Business.

Dr. Aslanyan is a research fellow at CERGE-EI (the Czech Republic) and junior professor of the Central Bank of Armenia. Starting from November 2016 he also holds a position of postdoctoral researcher at the Laboratory for International and Regional Economics of GSEM UrFU (Research Unit for Regional Economics).



Dr. Alberto Ferraris visited Gymnasium №104 together with Zhanna Belyaeva, Head of the programme International Economics and Business, to speak with senior high school students about career opportunities in the field of economics and management.

Dr. Ferraris is a postdoctoral researcher at the University of Turin. Since 2016, he is a research fellow at the Laboratory for International and Regional Economics of GSEM UrFU (Research Unit for Global Social Responsibility Excellence and International Business).



INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH SEMINAR

The methodological research seminar on applied economics was organised by Laboratory for International and Regional Economics (LIRE) on February 14–16 for students, postgraduate students and young researchers.

The workshop allowed master and PhD students and young faculty to present their research and got a feedback from prominent international research fellows.

The seminar was focused on methodological aspects of doing research and covered a number of lectures opened for interested faculty and students:

- How to do research in economics?
- Development of research ideas.

- How to publish papers in international journals.
- A view of publisher on world-class publication.
- Decision making and multi-agent approach.
- How to write a master thesis in the field of economics.
- Building and development of research career.

The reports were made by researchers from Graduate School of Economics and Management UrFU, New Economic School, Higher School of Economics and University of Turin. More than 80 GSEM faculty members, as well as PhD and master students participated during three days of the research seminar.

INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC COUNCIL

The International Academic Council of GSEM was founded in 2016. In February the Council had a first meeting regarding the results of GSEM Development Fund performance in 2016, as well as formulation of criteria for grant allocations in 2017. GSEM Development Fund allocates resources for educational programmes development, research teams support and staff participation in research conferences. The key principles of the Fund are equal opportunities for funding for all GSEM staff, as well as resources allocation based on professional expertise.

Four key projects will receive the most funding as decided by the Council. They are the Bachelor programme International Economics and Business (EPAS accredited), Master programme International Management (double degree with Lille 1 University), Laboratory for Applies System Research and Laboratory for International and Regional Economics

The GSEM academic staff will continue to be supported by means of travel grants for participation in the most important conferences and events: NRU HSE April Conference, Russian Economic Congress of Moscow State University, Shatalin Conference of the Central Economic and Mathematical Institute of Russian Academy of Sciences. International travel resulting in development of research will also be supported. Research teams will receive funding for participation in conferences with a report, organisation of research workshops and invitation of foreign researchers.

NEW EXCHANGE SEMESTER

GSEM was delighted to welcome new exchange students for spring 2017 in February. Currently students from partner universities in Germany, the Czech Republic, France, Brazil, Mexico, Taiwan, China, South Korea, and Kazakhstan are studying at the School on exchange.

DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMMES – RECENT GRADUATES

UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS - VARNA



First graduates of the double degree programmes with University of Economics – Varna were awarded diplomas of the Bulgarian partner on the first day of March.

Master programmes IT Innovations in Business and International eBusiness were opened in 2014 and from its beginning attracted a number of international students. In 2015, about 40 applications were submitted to the programme IT Innovations and Business from foreign applicants, 13 of which have successfully passed the inter-

view and entered the programme. At the same time, the Master's programme International eBusiness was developed in English and currently it provides training for students of the partner institution in the framework of academic exchange.

Marina Medvedeva, Academic Head of master programmes IT Innovations in Business and International eBusiness, comments: «I would like to express special gratitude to the leadership of the Faculty of Computer Science at University of Economics – Varna for our joint work on preparing and implementing the double degree programmes and joint research. For two years, more than 10 joint papers of faculty members of the Bulgarian university and Academic Department of Systems Analysis and Decision Making of GSEM were published. Another important achievement is that three foreign alumni of the programme continued their education in UrFU as PhD students, and two of them have started their work as assistants at our Academic Department».

«The double degree programme is one of the brightest and memorable parts of our training at the master level. We got acquainted with the culture of Bulgaria, learned a lot during the lectures and even met friends. Graduates of the programme International Management received their second diplomas Master Global Supply Chain Management from Lille 1 University (France). French professors taught lectures and supervised theses during the second year of their Master degree. Students successfully

defended their Master theses in English in front of the international jury.

The programme has been implemented jointly with IAE Lille 1 since 2010. Its goal is to train highly qualified managers for international companies and researchers in the field of contemporary management. Graduates of the programme have strong analytical, research and leadership, and teamwork skills.

Arnaud Rys, the programme head from IAE Lille, says: «The students who received diplomas Master Global Supply Chain Management can work in big European companies in Moscow or in Europe. We are also planning to organise internships in large European companies for the students so that they could open their own business after graduation».
